PUBLIC MEMO BOROUGH COUNCIL APRIL 27th, 2026, MEETING

The following will be discussed and considered at the April 27th meeting of Borough Council.

PUBLIC SAFETY:

1. Enterprise Fire Company Expenditure List (attached)
2. West Monument Avenue Speed Bumps/Traffic Calming - the borough is in receipt of a petition. Per the policy on traffic issues, a traffic study was done, and it is the opinion of the Chief of Police that the Borough should consider installing temporary speed bumps on West Monument Avenue. The Chief will discuss this on Monday night as well as answer questions from the Council and the public.

FINANCE/GRANTS COMMITTEE:

1. Union Library Expenditure List (attached)
2. Station at Hatboro Financial Security Release #2 - the developer has requested a second release of financial escrow as the project is nearing completion. The request has been reviewed by the engineer, and she is recommending council vote to authorize. This is a standard procedure for all developments and projects.
3. Monument Avenue Multimodal Transportation Fund Grant - The Borough held a town hall with residents in the area of the West Monument Bridge to see if they wanted the borough to proceed with this grant to replace the current wooden bridge. The overwhelming response from those in attendance was to keep the wooden bridge and return the grant funding agreement. The Borough does not have the funds in hand, just an agreement that council will vote to either keep or return the committed funds and not do the project.

COMMUNITY OUTREACH & EVENTS COMMITTEE:

1. Upcoming Events
2. Kat Hall Wiffle Ball Special Event Request - This is an annual event held at the Little League field. Council will consider approval.
3. Sidewalk Sale Special Event Request - This is the second year for a sidewalk sale organized by North York Road businesses. Council will consider approval.

PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE:

1. 2026 Road Paving - Public Works Foreman and Borough Manager are recommending the paving of Abbots Lane, Woodland & Wood Street for paving in 2026. The engineer has put together a cost

estimate to pave these streets and will review with Council at the meeting. Borough Council will need to authorize these streets for paving as well as authorize the engineer to prepare the bid packet and related documents so the project can go to bid.

ENVIRONMENTAL AFFAIRS & PARKS:

1. Update - Councilman Myers will provide an update on EAC and Tree Tenders activities for the past month.

ADMINISTRATION COMMITTEE:
