

HATBORO MEMORIAL POOL COVID-19 RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Social Distancing (please note, it is the parents' responsibility to have children adhere to these recommendations. The lifeguards' sole responsibility is to provide surveillance of patrons who may need a water rescue.
-
- Patrons must enter the facility through the front desk area. Patrons must exit through the fence gate located between the pool house and the snack stand. Staff will be present at the exit gate to count the number of patrons leaving the facility.
- Patrons MUST wear a face mask when entering the facility, exiting the facility, and when they are not in their designated family area or water.
- Patrons MUST bring their own furniture to the facility. No furniture will be provided to guests by the Borough.
- Grills will not be available for use during the season.
- Squares will be painted on the grounds for members to set up their belongings while maintaining social distancing. Family squares will measure 12'x12'. Single squares will measure 6'x6'. Isles and walking paths will be placed in between family squares to maintain social distancing between groups.
- Social Distancing markings will be present on the ground outside of the pool entrance for guests to practice social distancing while waiting to enter.
- The snack stand will not be open for the 2020 Season.
- The large red slide will not be open for the 2020 Season.
- Swimmers are required to remain 6ft apart while in the pool. The capacity inside the pool at any given time is 80. Family members do not need to abide with the social distancing restrictions.
- Pool toys and any activities that involve multiple people interacting in close proximity should be discontinued. Parents and chaperones of children, not lifeguards, are responsible if they would like their children to social distance while in the pool.
- Parents should consider if their children are capable of staying at least 6 ft apart from people they do not live with while at the pool.
- Exceptions to the social distancing guidelines include:
 - Anyone rescuing a distressed swimmer, providing first aid, or performing CPR with or without an AED.
 - Individuals in the process of evacuating the property due to an emergency.
- Repeated disregard to these safety measures by any member or guest will have consequences and will have their membership revoked.
- Members who purchase their membership on an EVEN calendar day will only be permitted in the pool on EVEN calendar days.
- Members who purchase their membership on an ODD calendar day will only be permitted in the pool on ODD calendar days.
- No guests will be permitted to enter the pool during the 2020 season. All patrons entering the pool MUST have a pool membership.

- The pool will be open for Senior Swim from 11 AM – 12 PM daily. Seniors can attend Senior Swim regardless of the day; however, must vacate the pool at 12 PM if it is not their day to swim per their membership card.
- If in the event that a member tests positive for COVID-19 or were exposed to someone with COVID-19 within the last 14 days, we are asking them to report this to the Borough Manager immediately.
 - If a report is made to the Borough Manager, the following measures will take place for notification purposes, all while maintaining confidentiality in accordance with the ADA.
 - The Montgomery County Health Department will be notified.
 - All members of the pool will be contacted and informed of the possible temporary closure of the facility.
 - Anyone who visited the pool on the day the exposed patron visited will be contacted
- Appropriate signage will be displayed around the facility regarding hand washing, social distancing, etc.
- Pool Staff will make announcements on the PA system throughout the day to remind patrons how to stop the spread of COVID-19.
- Per Pennsylvania and Montgomery County Health Code, all children in diapers MUST wear swimmy diapers with snug fitting plastic pants on top. Children should be encouraged to use the rest room before entry into the pools and periodically throughout their stay at the facility. Please note, fecal incidents require the immediate closure of the pool.
- Members must agree to all pool rules including COVID-19 regulations upon purchasing a memberships.
