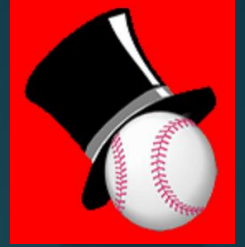

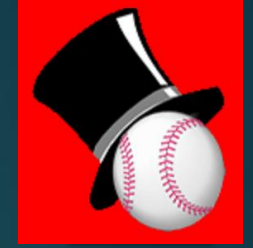

12 – SP STERIPHENE AERO DISINFECTANT



- PRE-GAME REQUIRMENTS FOR PLAYERS, COACHES AND FANS

ALL ATTENDEES TO THE COMPLEX MUST ADHERE TO THE FOLLOWING BEFORE EACH PRACTICE/GAME:

If you are not feeling well or have any of the following symptoms, no matter how mild they are, STAY AT HOME: fever, cough, breathing difficulties or shortness of breath, headache, sore throat, chills, shaking with chills, muscle pain, new loss of taste or smell.

Regardless of how you may feel, before coming to the HLL complex, check your temperature. Self-Temperature Check Guidelines Per CDC: If your temperature indicates a fever of 99 °F or greater, STAY HOME. You should then consult with your medical provider and continue to monitor your symptoms and temperature. You should not return until the later of: (a) 14days after the initial onset of your symptoms; and (b) the date on which your temperature is below 99 degrees for a continuous period of 72 hours, without the use of fever-reducing medications (e.g., Tylenol, aspirin, Ibuprofen, etc.).

Travel to and from games should be only with those who you are already in constant contact with

Practice social distancing(at least 6 feet (and if possible 10 feet) AT ALL TIMES. Avoid close contact with others while traveling from car to field.

Plan ahead as bathrooms will be closed



- IN-GAME REQUIRMENTS FOR PLAYERS, COACHES AND FANS

ALL ATTENDEES TO THE COMPLEX MUST ADHERE TO THE FOLLOWING DURING EACH PRACTICE/GAME:

THERE ARE NO DUGOUTS. Players will line their gear up 8 ft. apart along the outside of the fence

Parents / Fans are to follow all CDC Social Distance Guidelines

No spitting

No sharing of equipment or water

Umpire to stand behind pitcher

CATCHERS GEAR – Each team will receive two sets of catcher's gear with the goal to have only two players catch per game. SP Diffence Spray which has a 30 second kill time for Covid-19 will be used to spray off mask. Steriphene Disinfectant Spray is to be used on remaining equipment.

Players, Coaches and Attendees are encouraged, but required to wear masks.
